ORDER

The petitioner has filed this application for permission to undertake hot-line cleaning of insulators in Northern Region Transmission System through use of helicopters for a period of six months on an experimental basis in relaxation of the norms on O &M expenses in exercise of the powers of the Commission under Regulation 12 and 13 of the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms & Conditions of Tariff) Regulations, 2004 (hereinafter to be referred to as the "the tariff regulations, 2004").

- 2. The petitioner has stated that the transmission network in Northern Region comprises 20000 kms of lines and 16 numbers of sub-stations of voltage level up to 400 KV AC and ± 500 KV HVDC. During the winter season, there have been frequent outages of various EHV AC/HVDC lines on account of flashovers experienced by transmission line insulators in polluted stretches of the Northern Region, particularly in and around National Capital Region and the areas having high industrial/agricultural pollution. It has been further stated that on a number of occasions, the trippings had been so wide spread that Northern Region had come to the brink of near collapse.
- The petitioner has submitted that the requisite frequent and extensive cleaning of insulators is not feasible manually (which requires the lines to be switched off) due to high demand in winter season. One of the practices being followed worldwide is helicopter based live line cleaning of insulators. In a meeting convened by the petitioner on 6.1.2006 which was attended by the constituents

and officials of Northern Regional Power Committee and Central Electricity

Authority, a consensus has emerged for hotline washing of the transmission lines

with the help of helicopters. Accordingly, the petitioner has submitted this proposal

for hot line washing using helicopters on experimental basis for a period of six

months. M/s Pawan Hans Helicopters Ltd has agreed to provide necessary

equipments and helicopters for six months from October to March at an

approximate cost of Rs. 8.13 crore.

4. The petitioner has submitted that the O&M expenses as per the tariff

regulations,2004 does not cater for hotline washing of insulators by using the

helicopters, the petitioner has prayed for relaxation of the provisions of the

regulations by invoking the powers under regulations 12 and 13 of the tariff

regulations,2004.

5. Considering the importance and urgency involved in the matter, the petition is

admitted and the respondents are directed to file their replies to the petition by

21.8.2007.

6. List the matter for hearing on 30.8.2007.
