The representative of the petitioner submitted that the instant petition has been filed for determination of Fees and Charges for Fibre optic communication system under expansion of wideband communication network in Eastern Region for the period 2009-14 block.

- 2. The representative for the respondent OHPC made detailed submissions in the matter and has further submitted that reply was filed vide affidavit dated 8.3.2016.
- 3. The Commission after hearing the parties directed the petitioner to file its rejoinder in the matter on or before 11.4.2016 with copies to respondents. Further, the Commision directed the petitioner to submit the following information on affidavit, with an advance copy to respondents by 11.4.2016:
 - a) Documentary evidence in regard to delay of 2 months in commissioning of assets.
 - b) The reason and status of the remaining assets ,out of 2325 km OPGW cable a total of 1689 km cable has been installed.
 - c) Segregated apportioned approved cost for the assets and basis of apportionment.
 - d) The actual O&M cost yearwise along with details.

- 4. The Commission further directed the petitioner to file the above said information within the specified time. In case, the information is not filed within the said date, the matter shall be decided based on available records.
- 5. Subject to the above, order in the petition was reserved.
