Learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition has been filed under Section 79(1) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Sections 14 and 15 of Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for recognition and issuance of Renewable Energy Certificate for Renewable Energy Generation) Regulations, 2010 seeking direction against National Load Despatch Centre for illegal and arbitrary rejection of grant of REC application of the Petitioner.
