## Subject: Staff Paper on the "Blending of imported coal with domestic coal to mitigate the domestic coal shortage".

The recent sharp increase in electricity demand has necessitated that the thermal generating stations produce electricity to their maximum feasible level. However, shortage of domestic coal is constraining the generating stations to restrict their generation thereby resulting in shortfall in supply of energy. In order address this issue, the Ministry of Power directed the concerned stake holders to import at least 10 % of their requirement of coal for blending and higher amount blending in future, if required. However, it was expressed by some generating companies that they are facing a problem to comply the above direction of Ministry of Power on account delay and in some cases absence of permission by the concerned beneficiaries.
