Learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that in compliance with the Commission's direction vide order dated 2.8.2024, NRLDC has filed its affidavit dated 13.8.2024 indicating the percentage utilisation of Karcham- Jhakri line month-wise under ISTS using a hybrid methodology as per the 2020 Sharing Regulations. Learned counsel added that no suggestions or objections have been received in response to the public notice issued by the Commission under Section 15(5)(a) of the Electricity Act, 2003.

- The representative of the Respondent, NRLDC, also confirmed the filing of its 2. affidavit in terms of the Commission's direction dated 2.8.2024.
- Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner and the representative of NRLDC, the Commission directed NRLDC to file the following information on an affidavit within two weeks with a copy to the other side:
 - (a) Block-wise injection (in MW) at Baspa end and Wangtoo end for the peak blocks for the month of July 2023 in respect of the Baspa HEP.
 - (b) Who is scheduling the generation from the Baspa HEP, namely NRLDC or HPSLDC?
