Record of Proceedings

The representative of the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition has been filed seeking a separate transmission licence for the implementation of the three transmission projects, namely (i) Transmission System for evacuation of power from the REZ in Rajasthan (20 GW) under Phase III Part E1, (ii) Grant of 400 & 220 kV bays to the RE generators at Fatehgarh-III (erstwhile Ramgarh II) PS, and (iii) Bus Sectionalizer at 400 kV level of 765/400/220 KV Fatehgarh III PS (Section 2) under the Regulated Tariff Mechanism (RTM). The representative of the Petitioner further submitted that the Petitioner has complied with all the requirements under the Transmission Licence Regulations, and the CTUIL has submitted its recommendations for the grant of a transmission licence to the Petitioner under Section 15(4) of the Electricity Act, 2003.

- The representative of CTUIL confirmed that CTUIL has already issued its recommendations for the grant of a transmission licence to the Petitioner's company.
- 3. After hearing the representative of the Petitioner and the CTUIL, the Commission reserved the matter for order.
