Record of Proceedings

The Petitioner's representative submitted that the present Petition had been filed for the determination of transmission tariff from the anticipated COD to 31.3.2024 for 3 Nos. transmission assets under "Augmentation of Transformation Capacity" in the Southern Region. He further submitted that none of the Respondents had filed their reply in the matter.

2. None was present on behalf of the Respondents despite notice.

3. After hearing the Petitioner's representative, the Commission directed the Respondents to file their respective replies, if any, within a week with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, within a week thereafter.
